At Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., Wells Fargo Securities International Limited, other “Wells Fargo” named entities, ECM Asset Management Limited, Eastdil Secured, LLC, Evergreen entities, First International Advisors, LLC, Burdale Financial Limited, and their affiliated entities (“Wells Fargo/,” “we” or “us”), our priority is to protect your privacy and thus we observe the relevant laws relating to the treatment of Personal Information (as defined below). Unless we have your consent, we do not use Personal Information for purposes other than as outlined in this Notice. Moreover, we approach the protection of Personal Information appropriately and in good faith.

This privacy notice (“Notice”) applies to information collected by us in Mexico. If you have a relationship with or provided personal information to Wells Fargo in the U.S., Canada, or any other countries, the privacy policy or statement relating to the U.S., Canada, or such other country will govern any information collected in the course of that relationship. In addition, if you have separately received a privacy notice from a Wells Fargo company, that privacy notice governs any information collected in the course of that relationship.

1. Types of Information to be Collected

We primarily have relationships and accounts only with corporations or other legal entities outside the United States. However, we may collect information about representatives of our customer organizations (“Customers”) which can include: name, employer, title, position held, length of employment, documents that verify employment, work address and work phone number, signature authorization, passport, driver’s license, other governmental identification information, home address and telephone number, documents that verify address, date of birth, country of domicile, salary and other income, sources of wealth, assets, financial relationships, background check information, cellular telephone number and email address (“Personal Information”). A passport, driver’s license and background check information may contain information such as racial or ethnic origin and information about offenses, which constitutes sensitive Personal Information.

It is generally necessary for a Customer or its representative to provide the Personal Information outlined in this Section 1, and the information may be essential in order to carry out the purposes outlined in Section 2, including providing the requested services and complying with legal obligations. We may collect Personal Information directly from you, from publicly available sources or from our Customers. Failure to provide this information may result in Wells Fargo being unable to provide or continue to provide the requested services to the Customer.

2. Purposes of Collection

The purposes of collecting Personal Information are primarily those necessary to provide the services requested by our Customers and to comply with legal obligations and regulations as follows:

- To comply with “know your customer” obligations based on applicable anti-money laundering and anti-terrorism requirements, customer due diligence or other similar laws and regulations;
- To fulfill other legal and regulatory obligations pertaining to foreign exchange and international trade, tax reporting and other laws, regulations and ordinances applicable to Wells Fargo in any jurisdiction;
- To confirm a person’s authority as a representative or agent of a Customer with which Wells Fargo has entered or intends to enter various arrangements (including but not limited to deposit contracts, loan contracts, contracts for foreign exchange transactions, contracts for derivative transactions; and letters of credit);
- In market Wells Fargo products and services for business use;
- To refer Customers to a non-affiliated institution for other services;
- To provide the services requested by Wells Fargo Customers and communicate with Customers about those services; and
- To manage our business and improve our services.

In addition, we may use Personal Information for purposes of marketing Wells Fargo products and services for business use, which is not necessary for the legal relationship with the Customer. If you do not wish to have your Personal Information used for marketing purposes, you may contact us at the address in Section 7 below.

3. Use and Disclosure of Information

We may use your Personal Information for any of the purposes described in this notice or purposes compatible with such purposes and will endeavor not to use Personal Information for any purpose incompatible with the purposes listed above unless it is authorized by you, is necessary to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation, or is otherwise permitted by applicable law. Examples of situations which may permit us to collect, use and disclose your Personal Information include where it is necessary to comply with law or a legal obligation, where it is necessary to perform a contractual obligation or where it is necessary to accomplish our legitimate interest. We will comply with applicable law in connection with our collection, use and disclosure of your Personal Information. Your Personal Information may be accessible from worldwide locations including in countries that the European Commission or other countries or multilateral organizations have not determined provide the same level of data protection as in those countries.

Disclosures to Affiliated Entities

Wells Fargo has affiliated entities operating in the United States and around the world (see the most recent Form 10-K at <http://www.sec.gov/Archives/edgar/data/72971/000119312513078820/d450230dex21.htm> for a list of affiliated entities as of December 31, 2012). In order to carry out the purposes outlined in Section 2, Personal Information may also be made available to Wells Fargo affiliated entities on a worldwide basis.

Disclosures to Third Parties

Wells Fargo may from time to time need to make some Personal Information available to other parties that perform services on our behalf in connection with the necessary purposes and marketing purposes described above, including service providers, accountants, auditors and legal counsel. You cannot refuse to consent to our use of service providers for necessary purposes, but can refuse to consent to marketing purposes by notifying us at the address in Section 7 below. There are also a limited number of additional circumstances in which we may disclose your Personal Information to third parties such as:

- **Legal Requirements:** Subject to applicable law, we may disclose your Personal Information if required or permitted by law or regulation applicable to us, including laws and regulations of the United States and other countries, or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) comply with a legal obligation or in response to a request from public authorities, wherever we may do business; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Wells Fargo; (c) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of clients and workers/employees of Wells Fargo or the public; or (d) protect against any legal liability. In addition, we may share your Personal Information with our regulators and with other self-regulatory bodies to which we are subject, wherever we may do business.
- **Business Transfers, Combinations and Related Activities:** As we develop our business, we might sell, buy, restructure or reorganize businesses or assets. In the event of any actual or proposed sale, merger, reorganization, restructuring, dissolution or any similar event involving our business or assets, Personal Information may be shared with the relevant entity or may be part of the transferred assets.

4. Consents

To the extent that your consent is required by applicable law and our collection, use, disclosure or transfer of your Personal Information is not otherwise permitted by applicable law, by providing Personal Information to Wells Fargo or authorizing our Customer to provide your Personal Information to us, you consent to the collection, use, disclosure and transfer (including cross-border transfers) of your Personal Information as described in this Notice.

You may revoke consent at any time by notifying us at the address provided in Section 7 of this notice. Prior uses and disclosures will not be affected (unless required by applicable law) and we may continue to use your Personal Information as permitted or required by law.

5. Information Management and Security Control Measures

Appropriate measures are taken so that Personal Information can be kept accurate, and up-to-date. In an effort to prevent the loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction of Personal Information, Wells Fargo will take appropriate legal, organizational and technical measures to protect Personal Information. We will not keep Personal Information longer than necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Policy and have implemented appropriate record retention policies.

While registering with our website, we may provide you with a unique identification and password for accessing our products and services. We advise you to choose your password wisely such that no intruder or third party can obtain any unauthorized access. We also encourage you to keep your password confidential and not have any written or other record of the password that can be accessible by an intruder or third party

6. Requests for Access, Correction or Discontinuation of Use of Personal Information

Access and Correction

Requests to access or correct any Personal Information held about you must be submitted in writing to the address listed in the Customer Inquiries and Complaints at Section 7 below. After we have verified your identity, we will endeavor to provide you with the information you have requested within the time specified by Mexican law or within a reasonable period of time, and, where permitted by law, may charge an appropriate fee to cover the costs of responding to the request.

If the information about you is determined to be inaccurate, we will endeavor to correct it as appropriate. If we decline to provide the Personal Information held or to make the correction requested, we will provide you with the reasons for declining the request.

Opt-Out of Receiving Marketing Materials

If you do not want to receive marketing and sales materials by direct mail, telephone or email, please submit a written request to the address listed in the Customer Inquiries and Complaints at Section 7 below. We will comply with your request within a reasonable period of time after receiving it.

Other Legal Rights

You may have other rights under the laws applicable to our collection of your Personal Information. Contact us in writing with requests to exercise such rights at the address listed in the Customer Inquiries and Complaints at Section 7 below and we will honor such rights in accordance with law.
